We are reaching out to inform you that **Gateway will be extending our school closure until May 1, 2020**, along with all SFUSD public schools and five other Bay Area districts.

Gateway staff have been hard at work converting lessons to home learning models and checking in with students. In the next several days you will be receiving more information from your child’s school and teachers about what you and your child can expect academically after spring break and until regular school resumes.
