SFUSD's Free Lunch Program

Beginning Tuesday, March 17, SFUSD will provide free breakfast and lunch to all children 18 and younger at pick-up sites across San Francisco. Packaged breakfast and lunch meals for pick-up and take-away will be available Monday through Friday on a first-come, first-serve basis.
