



### **Grab & Go Meals Continue to be available to Gateway students**

As the school year begins with distance learning, SFUSD Student Nutrition Services will continue to provide nutritious school meals for students. Since SFUSD provides meal service to Gateway, **Gateway students can get Grab and Go meals at various sites throughout SF.** Please note that beginning August 19, meals will be available to **students only** and that families must provide the student's barcode for their meal account when picking up meals. **If your student is not eligible for free or reduced-price meals, \$22.50 per bag will be charged to their SchoolCafe account.**

**All Gateway students must complete a new Multipurpose Family Income form (MFIF) for the 20-21 school year.** The form for the 20-21 school year is available online at [sfusd.edu/MFIF](https://sfusd.edu/MFIF). The form is available in English, Arabic, Chinese, Spanish, Tagalog, and Vietnamese. A new application needs to be submitted each school year to qualify for meal benefits.
