GMS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

The following information will help you prepare for enrollment and success at Gateway Middle School!

- *Q:* When will I have more opportunities to learn about and meet others in the Gateway community?
- A: At Gateway, community is important to us! This Spring, we will be hosting a Sixth Grade Family Pizza Party & Welcome Night on Wednesday, May 3, 2017 from 6 – 7:30PM. There is also a Mandatory Orientation, Family Work Day and Back –to-School Picnic leading up to the first day of school. You'll have a chance to meet administrators, teachers, families and other students in the Gateway community.

Q: When does school start?

- *A:* We have a Mandatory 6th Grade Orientation on Friday, August 18, 2017 from 8:15am-12:15pm and our first day will be on August 21, 2017. Once we have finalized the entire school-year calendar, it will be available on our website: www.gatewaymiddle.org.
- *Q:* How do we register our child in the San Francisco Unified School District?
- *A*: We will use the SFUSD Charter School Enrollment Form that you submitted with your enrollment response form to inform SFUSD that you will be attending Gateway. There is no need for you to contact SFUSD directly.
- *Q:* If I don't live in San Francisco, how do I apply for an Interdistrict Transfer?
- *A*: In order to enroll in the San Francisco Unified District, you must visit your home district office and apply to transfer. Once you do so, your home district will forward information to the San Francisco Unified School District. Any student who has been admitted to Gateway will be approved by the SFUSD for an Interdistrict Transfer.
- *Q:* What does Gateway Middle School expect of new students before the first day of school and should we expect more information in the mail?
- A: We expect all students to complete their summer reading/writing assignments and to attend our mandatory WEB Orientation on August 18, 2017 from 8:15AM – 12:15PM at Gateway Middle School. Over the summer, you will receive additional forms required to attend Gateway. These forms include emergency/medical information.
