# **5 Factors To Consider When Choosing A High School**

## 1) School Size

Do you want a small school where you are well known, but might have fewer extracurricular options? Or do you want a large school that has a lot of electives and sports teams, but you might not be as well known?

## 2) Academic Program

What type of academic programs and course offerings are there at this particular school? Things to consider are whether the school has academies, college prep courses, arts, languages and other electives. etc.

### 3) Extracurricular Options and Sports

What type of sports and extracurricular are there at this particular school?

# 4) School Community and Values

What does the school community feel like? Is it somewhere that you feel that you can belong for the next four years?

#### 5) College Preparatory Program

How does the school prepare students for going to college? Consider course selection as well as support with college applications, etc.

### Application Deadline:

- Regular Application Deadline: January 13, 2017

- o Parent/Guardian identification
- o Proof of child's birth date
- Two forms that prove San Francisco residency



# SFUSD High Schools – Lowell and SOTA Separate Application

NOTE: There is a separate application process for Lowell and SOTA:

#### Lowell

Application Deadline: TBD by SFUSD office. You will need to fill out both the standard SFUSD application as well as a separate Lowell application. Students can pick up the Lowell applications from Mr. Angelo.

Lowell 8<sup>th</sup> Grader Night – Lowell will host an Open House in the fall, date TBD. Please contact Mr. Angelo for tickets to the event. Lowell will give two tickets per student and tickets are needed for entrance.

Entrance Exam – Students applying to Lowell will need to take an entrance exam as part of the application process. The exams are typically proctored in early January. This year's dates are, as consistent for Lowell, TBD.

#### **SOTA**

Application Deadline: December 7<sup>th</sup> for the first round of auditions on January 7, 2017.

SOTA applications are restricted to students living in the City of San Fransisco.
